Ellerker Emergency Ice and Snow Plan

In the event of extreme ice and snow conditions the Clerk would expect to be contacted by East Riding of Yorkshire Council when the Emergency Payments become available.

The application forms could then be downloaded, printed off and sent to the Chairman of the Parish Council. The Chairman would then fill in the details and contact the local contractor, Mr Tony Barratt, who carries out beck clearing duties for us. He has all the necessary machinery and capability to clear ice and snow on the roads and footpaths. He also purchases salt and grit for us in such circumstances. Last year he did a very prompt satisfactory job.

He would then submit his invoice, which we would pay out of the emergency payment. We would then send any balance left, back to the ERYC and repay any VAT that we can claim back.

I understand that there is a long standing agreement with the Village Hall committee to use the Village Hall as a meeting point in the case of any emergency.

An article in the Ellerker News asking for people to volunteer to be on a list of helpers in the case of heavy snow did not produce any results. Last year the village all pulled together anyway, with people helping vulnerable neighbours without any formal organisation.
