## QUESTIONS?

How long does it take to upgrade to superfast broadband? This depends on your provider, but typically it will take a couple of weeks. It's an easy process. Go to the postcode checker to see if superfast broadband is available in your area, then either upgrade with your existing provider or choose a new one. Go to their website or phone their helpline and follow the steps to upgrade. How does my provider install superfast broadband?

Your provider will arrange a convenient time with you for an engineer to call round to install superfast broadband in your home.

How much extra does it cost? This again depends on your provider. Typically it will cost around £10 to £20 extra per month to upgrade. Some providers also offer introductory deals with lower costs for the first months.

What happens if I have an existing broadband contract?

Either wait for the contract to come to an end and then choose your superfast broadband supplier or talk to your current broadband supplier about upgrading earlier.

How many devices can I run on superfast broadband?

With superfast broadband you can run multiple devices all at once. You and your family can game, stream, download and chat, all together with no buffering.

How many people have signed up to superfast broadband? Nearly 30% of residential broadband connections are now superfast. And more people are going superfast every week. The Government is investing £1.7 billion to enhance the commercial roll out of superfast broadband and

extend mobile infrastructure.
